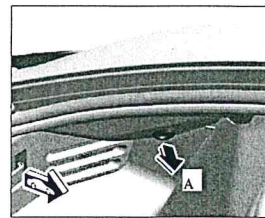

1. Remove rubber stopper -1- (-A-).

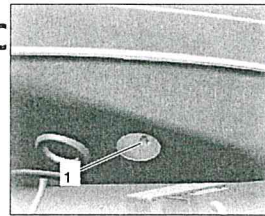

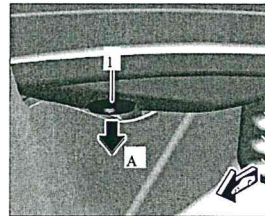

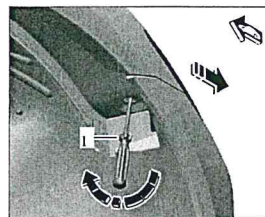
2. Remove rubber stopper -1- in the wheel housing -A-.



Removing rubber stopper

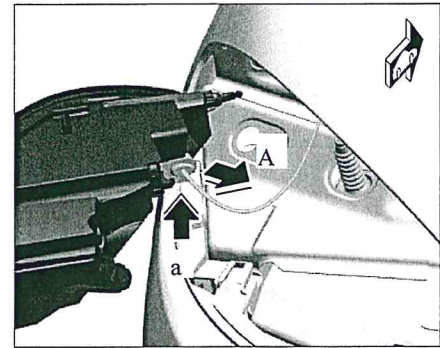
Insert a screwdriver through the opening -1- and position it on the removal surface of the light. Press the light out of the ball socket using a levering motion -A-.

Secure the light from outside to prevent it from falling down.

3. Release electric plug connection -a- and pull it off -A-.



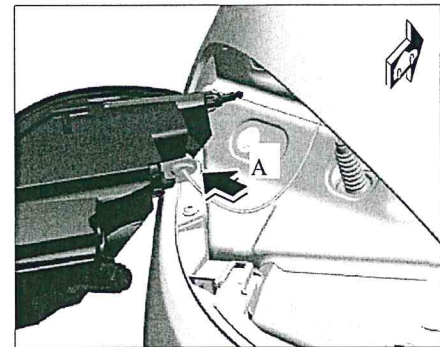
Electric plug connection for tail light

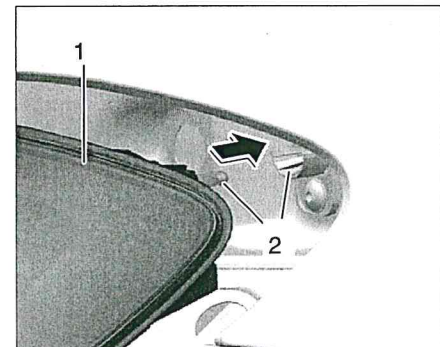
Installing tail light

1. Plug in electric plug connection **-A-** until the connector engages securely.



Connecting electric plug connection

2. Pre-position tail light **-1-** so that the T-bolts run into the guide rail. Slide in the tail light **-1-** and press it into the locking mechanism **-2-**.

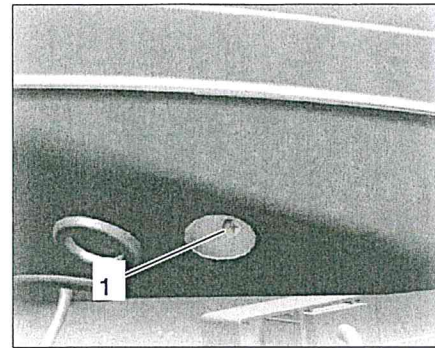


Installing tail light

3. Screw in fastening screw **-1-** for the tail light and tighten to Tightening torque 2.0 Nm (1.5 ftlb.) +10 % -15 %.

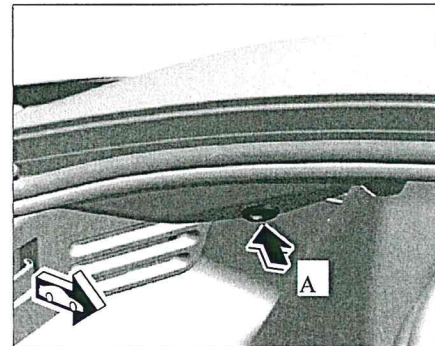

1 - Fastening screw



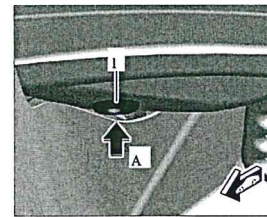
Securing tail light
